## #1 WHEN SHOULD I SPAY?

Cats should be at least 5 months of age before we consider them a good candidate for spay.

LASER PACKAGE

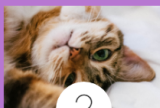
CO2 laser that allows for less bleeding, and faster healing times

### Preparing for the Big Day



#### What to do!



- DO plan on dropping on between 7:45-8:30 am the morning of the procedure
- DO allow 10-15 minutes for a technician to review the consent form
- DO plan on picking up the day of the procedure between 4:30 - 6 pm
- DO allow 10-15 minutes to review the discharge instructions

#### What not to do!



- DO NOT feed anything after 10 pm the night before the procedure
- DO NOT withhold water overnight
- DO NOT allow any running, jumping or playing while the incision is healing (10-14 days)
- DO NOT allow your kitty to lick at their incision!

#### SCHEDULING CONFLICT?

Don't worry about it!

Ask us about dropping off the night before or picking up the morning after surgery.
